A New High Quality June-bearing Strawberry from The East Malling Strawberry Breeding Club

- High % Class 1
- Good fruit size
- Sweet flavour with high Brix levels
- Slightly earlier than Elsanta

Fruit Quality


Excellent overall fruit quality. Berries are firm and attractive with very regular shape and excellent flavour. Brix and shelf life scores have been similar to Elsanta, although berries of Malling™ Centenary appear to retain their gloss and shine better after storage. In the AHDB Horticulture-funded substrate grown strawberry variety trial (SF 128), Malling™ Centenary achieved excellent scores for appearance, flavour, firmness and shelf life (Table 1).



Malling™ Centenary had a similar 50% harvest date to Elsanta in the EMR 2008 main crop and 2009/10 60-day trials. In 2010 and 2011 main crop trials it was slightly earlier than Elsanta.

Yield and Fruit Size

Good fruit size (average 76% large) and percentage Class 1 (average 93%) across all trials at EMR. In the AHDB Horticulture-funded substrate grown strawberry variety trial (SF 128), Malling™ Centenary produced the highest 60-day Class 1 yield of all varieties tested, including 22% more than Elsanta (Table 1). Malling™ Centenary produced a very high percentage of Class 1 fruit, with 63% of this being large (35-45mm) sized berries compared to 43% for Elsanta.

Plant Characteristics

Nice plants with similar vigour to Elsanta, but with bigger leaves. Fruit is very well displayed.

Pest & Disease Resistance

Although preliminary tests from EMR suggest that Malling™ Centenary does not have any strong resistance to common diseases, no problems have been reported from trial sites or nursery beds.
