



Phytosanitary problems:

- fire blight (*Erwinia amylovora*) quince, pear, apple.
- Plum pox (Sharka, *Prunus virus 6*) stone fruits.
- Psilla pear.





Species: apple Varieties: Gold Rush, Rubinola, Topaz Planting system and canopy: vertical axe, 3.5 x 1.0 m

- Flame weed cleaner –MAITO, Italy
- Flame wooly aphid killer

Resistant species - Berries - high demand:

- blueberry
- chokeberry (Aronia melanocarpa)
- Go Ji (Lycium barbarum)





-High demand:

- walnut no clonal propagated trees available
- sea buckthorn mainly for organic and export
