



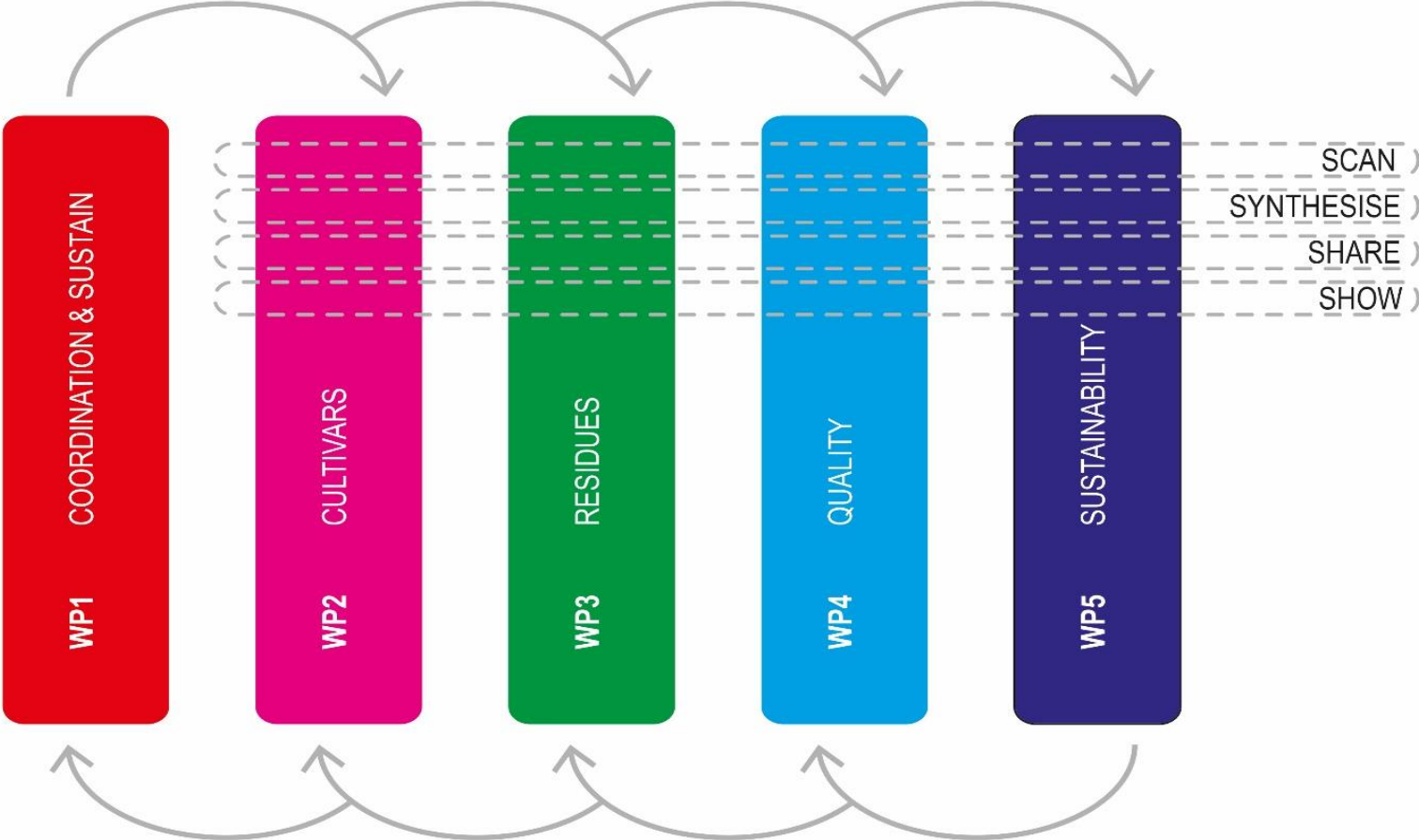

- All 6 mo and 18 mo milestones achieved

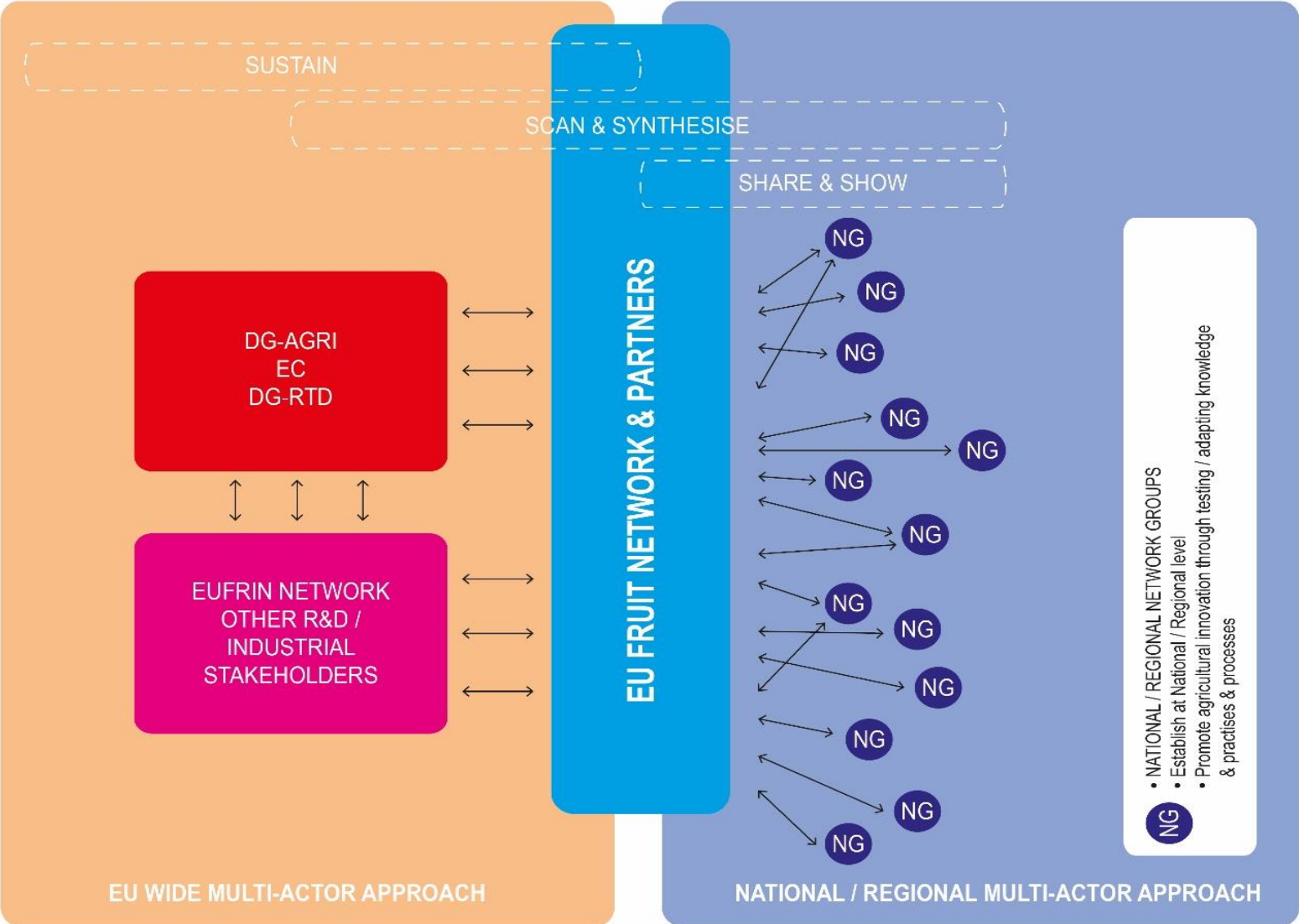


Work carried out in EUFRUIT

- 1 Consortium start up meeting (2016), 1 GA (2016) + 2 GA (2017)
- 8 International Expert Group Meetings (IEG; 2016 & 2017)
- 174 international national experts involved in IEGs
- 144 scanning reports delivered + 8 synthesis reports

Dissemination carried out in EUFRUIT

- 59 National / Regional Groups (NGs) established:
 - 41 Regional
 - 14 National
 - 4 across National boundaries
 - > 30,000 email contacts (from individuals to large cooperatives)
- National / regional dissemination ('share and show') has delivered:
 - 129 seminars and workshops
 - 474 field-based meetings, open days, field visits, grower meetings
 - 232 participation in industry events, exhibitions, conferences with industry stakeholders
 - 52 events aimed at the general public

EUFRUIT Knowledge Platform is an international open access database of electronic documents related to productivity, sustainability and quality of fruit in the European fruit sector. New knowledge on fruit research and best practice approaches at a European level are available in the database. It is possible to search for information in a specific language.

Focuses are on four thematic areas of critical importance to competitiveness and innovation potential of the European fruit sector:

- Performance of new fruit varieties
- Reduction in pesticide residues
- Fruit quality; improvement of fruit handling/storage
- Secure sustainable fruit production
